Eligibility Checking Service for claimants of Free School Meals, Funded Early Learning, Pupil Premium and 30 Hours Free Childcare by DCC

Privacy Notice – Data Protection Act 1998

We collect information, and may receive and hold information about your child in relation to claims for Free School Meals, Funded Early Learning, Pupil Premium or 30 Hours Free Childcare in compliance with the following legislation:

- Education Act 2005
- Childcare Act 2006
- Childcare Act 2016
- Childcare (Early Years Provision Free of Charge) (Extended Entitlement) Regulations 2016
- Data Protection Act 1998

We will not give information about you (or your child) to anyone outside the Council without your consent unless the law permits us to. We are required by law to pass some of your information to the Department for Education (DfE).

Eligibility information is obtained via the Department for Education (DfE) secure [eligibility checking service](#) which carries out checks against data held by [HM Revenue and Customs \(HMRC\)](#), the [Department for Work and Pensions \(DWP\)](#) and the [Home Office](#) for the purpose of confirming that you meet the eligibility criteria relating to earnings and/or benefits. Derbyshire County Council will then receive confirmation of your eligibility and eligibility confirmation data will be shared with educational settings your child attends via a secure web site provided by [Servelec Group plc](#).

Information obtained from the [eligibility checking service](#) will only be used by Derbyshire County Council for the purpose of assessing the eligibility for claims for Free School Meals or Funded Early Learning or Pupil Premium or 30 Hours Free Childcare within Derbyshire.

To ensure there is no abuse of personal data we have the following controls, safeguards and limitations in place in regard to the use of and the sharing of the above information:

- a) the information will not be used for any purpose other than those stated in this notice
- b) receipt of one of the prescribed benefits or 30 Hours eligibility will be checked by the local authority with the appropriate government departments e.g. HMRC, DWP and Home Office
- c) any entitlement or change in entitlement status will be shared by the local authority with the school or setting that the child attends
- d) the information may be used to ensure accuracy of records across the local authority and to protect public monies against fraud.

- e) the information will only be held for periods proscribed in the Council's Record Retention Schedules after which it will be destroyed. The Council's Record Retention Schedules can be found here: www.derbyshire.gov.uk/retentionschedules
