I know I mentioned this last week but we'd encourage parents to check phones and make sure that children are only accessing apps that are age appropriate.

Parental controls

Parental controls allow you to block and filter upsetting or inappropriate content. They work across your Wi-Fi, phone network, individual apps and devices.

Parental controls can help you to:

- plan what time of day your child can go online and how long for
- create content filters to block apps that may have inappropriate content
- manage the content different family members can see.
